Sex kitten's pa shocked at her career

FOXY FUGITIVE Jaynie Mae Baker, the 30-year-old stunner tied to the Soccer Mom Madam, has few family ties and hasn't seen her father in over two decades.

Baker, still being sought by authorities in connection with a high-end prostitution ring, worked as a recruiter for an upscale matchmaking service. She's also connected to the flesh-peddling trade, law enforcement sources said.

Baker's father, reached by the Daily News on Thursday, said that he hasn't seen his daughter since she was 7 years old. And he hasn't been a father to Jaynie since she was 4 — when his marriage went bust and her mother moved out.

Jody Baker, a civilian employee at Scott Air Force Base in Illinois, was dumbfounded to learn what authorities said his little girl was wrapped up in.

"I'm shocked, bewildered," he said outside his home in Mascoutah, Ill.

"Naturally, when you have children, you want the best for them. You hope all goes well with them."

The estranged dad got emotional.

"I love her and I miss her, and I hope she does the right thing," he said. "I don't know what else to say. I'm going to start to cry."

Jaynie Baker, who sources say was indicted with her partner Anna Gristina for running an upper East Side prostitution ring catering to wealthy men, has a warrant out for her arrest.

Friends say the Brooklyn blond, who bought a million-dollar condo on the Williamsburg waterfront with her sister last year, could be in California.

Baker's whereabouts is just one of the many mysteries of this case.

After five years of wiretaps, undercover work and confidential informants, legal experts find it odd that these women are the culmination of the investigation.

"This indictment seems odd" said **Jeremy Saland**, a defense lawyer who worked in the Manhattan District Attorney's office for over eight years. "There's something bigger here. There has to be something else to legitimize a five-year investigation beside a one-count "D" felony."

He said the fact that it started out as an official corruption investigation makes him believe that others will be charged.

Sources have told The News that Gristina, 44, bragged about having friends in law enforcement, including the NYPD, FBI and ICE. She claimed they would alert her before authorities were about to bust the prostitution ring. mgrace@nydailynews.com
